  - Community infrastructure



#### Where can local authorities help?

- •Up to date information such as location of key infrastructure, flood risk assessments, economic and archaeological data.
- •Help assess the risks to people and the built and natural environment
- Collection and consideration of stakeholders' concerns and objectives
- Planning policy
- •Identify the consequences of putting SMP policy into practice

#### The outputs?

- Policy statements for each management unit
- •A realistic and affordable management plan for the SMP

#### The process in outline is:

- Collect data and confirm an understanding of coastal processes and how the shoreline is behaving
- Define key features, benefits, issues and set objectives
- Identify the risks
- Assess the objectives
- Consult on policy scenarios, amend and finalise the SMP
- •Implement the SMP

#### The planning system and community strategies

The SMP process should be supporting the planning system

- Informing the Regional Spatial Strategy
- Identify areas at risk of flooding
- Predicting long term change in the coastline
- Developing appropriate LDF policy
- •Identifying risks where there are coastal development plan sites
- •Information on whether coast protection for a development is viable or would need mitigation
- Feeding into the local Community Strategy
